## Pastor's Corner

*Dear Brothers and Sisters,*

This weekend, we celebrate Palm Sunday. Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week, and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before he was crucified.

Palm Sunday is known as such because the faithful will often receive palm fronds which they use to participate in the reenactment of Christ's arrival in Jerusalem. In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of Him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect.

Palm branches are widely recognized as a symbol of peace and victory, hence their preferred use on Palm Sunday. The use of a donkey instead of a horse is highly symbolic. It represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war. A week later, Christ would rise from the dead on the first Easter.

During Palm Sunday Mass, palms are distributed to parishioners who may carry them in a ritual procession into church. The palms are blessed, and many people will fashion them into small crosses or other items of personal devotion.

Because the palms are blessed, they may not be discarded as trash. Instead, they are appropriately gathered at the church and incinerated to create the ashes that will be used in the following year's Ash Wednesday observance.

The colors of the Mass on Palm Sunday are red, symbolizing the redemption in blood that Christ paid for the world.

As this being our celebration of this most sacred week, let us unite ourselves more deeply to our crucified Lord, so that we may journey with Him through His Passion to the glory of the Resurrection!

### **EMERGENCY BLOOD SHORTAGE**






**HOLY WEEK***Reflection on Mark 14:1–15:47*

Today, we enter the holiest week of the year by hearing the story that we will ponder and reflect on for the rest of the week, as it unfolds through these days more deliberately, in smaller segments.

The key to the Passion Story we hear today, and to this coming week of worship, lies in accepting the Passion of Jesus as real and present, and not just a ritual enactment. These are not just historical events that we are remembering, but continuing acts of love in a story of God's love that is unfolding today in your life and mine. We heard this on the first day of Lent: The time is here! Salvation is now! If we die with Christ now, we will rise with Him now.

So, take your place in the Passion Story. How will it touch you this year? How will it surprise you? Challenge you? How is it saving you now?
