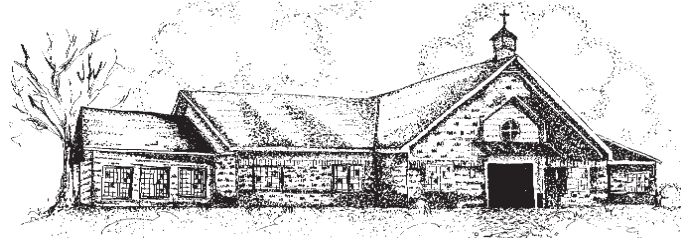

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AMAZING PARISH PROGRAM

Several years ago, a group of lay people and a few clergy who love the Church got together to see what could be done to enhance the life of parishes, to make them amazing, if you will. What came out of this endeavor is what is called, "The Amazing Parish" program.

This program exists to revitalize the Church by equipping her pastors and leaders with the training, resources, and support they need to create vibrant and thriving parishes or to make already vibrant parishes even more so.

Although every parish is unique, they have found that there are three common "building blocks" that form the foundation of an amazing parish:

- a) A reliance on prayer and the Sacraments
- b) A commitment to a healthy organization
- c) A passion for evangelization and discipleship

Many of our parishes in the Diocese of Columbus have participated in this program and have benefitted from it. It is a three-day program for the pastor and leadership team of the parish. The next one is in May in Cincinnati and our parish has received a \$2,000.00 grant from the Catholic Foundation to attend. I attended with some of my staff from St. Patrick Parish in London several years ago and many good things came from it. More people in the parish got involved with Parish Ministries. Please pray for us as we prepare to attend this conference in May.

This grant will help our leadership team to attend "The Amazing Parish" Conference. We are proud that our ministry is being acknowledged and supported for all the good work we do.
