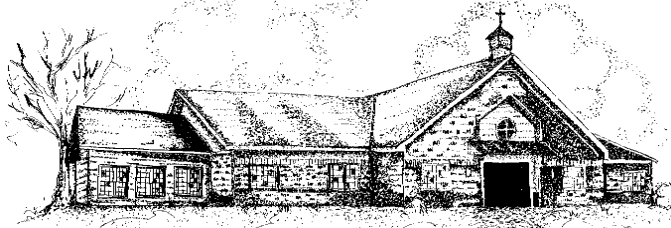

Our Mission Appeal speaker this weekend is **Father Jeremy Davis** of the **Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity (S.O.L.T.)**. He serves at Santa María del Mexicano, which is a boarding school for the troubled youth and children of Mexico. For over 40 years, Santa María has been a home and a family to the poor, disadvantaged, neglected, and abandoned youth of Mexico. The mission includes a home for the elderly who also come from challenging life situations. Santa Maria offers spiritual, educational, moral, vocational, and human formation to the most needy youth and elderly of Mexico. We offer the person a saving message of Jesus in a family environment - a Catholic atmosphere which appreciates and develops the gifts of each person. Through prayer, work, and education this nonprofit institution serves those who find themselves in need, in difficult life situations such as low income, difficult family situations, abuse, or neglect. Santa Maria works with families to provide the most integral and necessary care for each person. The institution consists of five separate houses in and surrounding the town of Colón in the Mexican state of Querétaro. It provides primary, secondary, and high school education to all of its youth.

- San Jose: a home for boys in grades 1-6
  - Santa Maria, Casa de Muchachos: a home for adolescent boys in grades 7-12
  - Casa de Ninas: girls in grades 1-6
  - Casa de Jovenes (muchachas): a home for adolescent girls grades 7-12
  - Home for the elderly and also the administrative offices
