## Pastor's Corner

#### Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Sunday, the Church comes to the middle of Lent. She marks the occasion by calling for a small pre-Easter celebration of joy. Today is called Laetare Sunday in Latin, with the word laetare meaning "rejoice." And so, today is "Rejoice Sunday."

Are we rejoicing? What are we supposed to be rejoicing about?

The entire Lenten season points us to celebrating and reliving the Paschal Mystery, namely, the Passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. In order for us to live this mystery, we must cooperate with grace and let it draw us closer and closer to the Lord. The spiritual tradition of the Church calls this the purgative way.

We can see an example of the purgative way in the blind man in today's Gospel reading. The man goes from calling the Lord "the man called Jesus," to "a prophet," to recognizing Him as "the Son of Man."

As with the blind man, so with each of us. The Lord wants to draw us close to Him. For this to happen, we must accept the purgative way.

The purgative way is an interior purification of our souls. It is a divine "cleaning up" and maturing of our hearts to the supernatural life offered to us in Jesus Christ.

Saint Paul expresses this reality, when he writes: "I have been crucified with Christ; yet I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me; insofar as I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God who has loved me and given himself up for me."

In the darkness of the purgative way, God reorients the soul. Our feelings, which usually want to follow our passions, are spiritualized and channeled to a deeper love of God and

Since grace belongs to the supernatural order, it escapes our experience and can only be known by faith. While our feelings may not experience it, God is close to us in the purgative way. He can bring about a great work in our souls if we allow Him. It is very important that we realize the place and purpose of the purgative way – there is a goal. The spiritual suffering leads us to a greater freedom and to a deeper relationship with God.

In the purgative way, we must permit a harrowing of our faith. While first given to us as a supernatural gift in Baptism, we are called to fan our faith into a flame.

As with the blind man in our Gospel today, the purgative way can involve misunderstanding, rejection, internal confusion, and frustration.

Through the process of purgation, we must cling to the sure conviction that God is with us, he loves us, and desires for us to know him in a more profound way. He wants us to experience and relive the Paschal Mystery. As the Lord Jesus underwent the Paschal Mystery, so each of us as "sons in the Son" are called to do the same.

There is no spiritual growth without the purgative way. There is no path to go from seeing the Lord Jesus as a man, to a prophet, to the Son of Man without spiritual purification. If we are going to truly know Jesus Christ, the Crucified and Risen One, then misconceptions must be dismissed, false images must be reformed, and love must be intensified. Such a work only happens through the school of suffering. Such depth can only be given through the Paschal Mystery.

As we rejoice this Sunday, we are called to welcome the purgative way, so that when Holy Week comes, we'll be ready to liturgically celebrate the Paschal Mystery that we are actively living in our own lives.




#### CATHOLIC SCHOOL HOUSE HOMESCHOOL CO-OP







#### **MESSENGER**


Reflection on John 3:14-21

Sometimes the messenger is a complete stranger, maybe someone at the door or on the other end of the call, who confronts me with my impatience, or rudeness, or prejudice I have nurtured.

Sometimes the messenger is my inner voice that comes when all is quiet and still and I have a chance to review the day – what I have done and said – and bring it to the light.

In the first reading from the book of Chronicles we are told that "early and often did God send his messengers to his people..." God is still sending His messengers to us, to wake us up to renewal and reform. As John says today, God did not send His Son into the world for a visit, but for life, for eternity. Jesus is ever-present as we encounter Him in His Word and in the Eucharist, in creation and sacrament, in the unique giftedness of each human person. We are called to be open to His messengers, bearers of grace and instruction, so that we may experience all that God desires for us: abundant life!


