Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On the evening of March 12, our parish will be hosting several local priests for our annual Lenten Penance Service. This is a wonderful opportunity for us to come together in our own weakness to seek out the mercy of God. I invite you to join us on March 12 beginning at 7:00 p.m. Bring your sin, your sorrow and fears and lay them before the wonderful mercy of God!

In this weekend's Gospel, we hear the story of Jesus expressing His righteous anger by casting out the money changers and those who were only in the temple area for personal profit. Jesus makes clear that the temple is the house of God and should be treated as such.

What is important in this story, is that we must understand what sort of "anger" Jesus had. Normally when we speak of anger, we mean a passion that is out of control and, in fact, controlling us. It's the loss of control and is a sin. But this is not the anger Jesus had. Obviously, Jesus was perfect in every way, so we must be very careful not to equate His anger with our normal experience of anger. Yes, it was a passion for Him, but it was different from what we normally experience. His anger was an anger that resulted from His perfect love.

In Jesus' case, it was love for the sinner and His desire for their repentance that drove His passion. His anger was directed at the sin they were engrossed in and He willfully and intentionally attacked the evil He saw. Yes, this may have been shocking to those who witnessed it, but it was, in that situation, the most effective way for Him to call them to repentance.

At times, we will find that we also must be angered by sin. But be careful! It's very easy for us to use this example of Jesus to justify losing control of ourselves and entering into the sin of anger.

Righteous anger, as Jesus manifested, will always leave one with a sense of peace and love for those who are rebuked. There will also be an immediate willingness to forgive when true contrition is perceived.

Perhaps in this Lenten Season, we can reflect upon the righteous anger God may want to put into our hearts at times. Again, be careful to discern it correctly. Do not allow yourself to be deceived by this passion. Rather, allow the love of God for others to be the driving force and allow a holy hatred for sin to direct you to act in a holy and just way. It is through this emulation of Christ that we can call the sinner to repentance and seek the loving mercy of God. God seeks the salvation of souls; may we be His conduit of grace in the world.


HOMESCHOOL GATHERING

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT MARCH 3, 2024

BELOVED

Reflection on Mark 9:2-10

The transfiguration of Jesus in today's Gospel is closely linked to His Baptism by John in the Jordan. On both occasions the sky speaks those words of generative love: "This is my beloved Son..."

At Jesus' Baptism, Mark reports that the proclamation, "This is my beloved Son," is followed by "with you I am well pleased." Each of us hear those same words spoken to us personally at Baptism, when we begin our lifelong journey of faith. At every stage of that journey, in every moment, we are embraced as daughters and sons who are beloved by God, and with whom God is pleased. This reality, this status of belonging in a royal, holy household, is not earned, but pure gift. God delights in you, His son, His daughter.

Whenever I hear this transfiguration story, where God follows those words of generative love with the command, "Listen to him," I am reminded of the last recorded words of Mary, the beloved Mother of Jesus, in the Gospel: "Do whatever he tells you." (from the wedding feast at Cana)

Listen to Him, and Do whatever He tells you. This journey of faith is a story that is the Word of God told throughout human history. It is told in the lives of our ancestors, and written by God with our lives as well. Listening to His Word, and doing what He instructs us to do, involves a daily and sometimes hourly choice to act in this world as if it were true that God is love, despite any evidence to the contrary.


